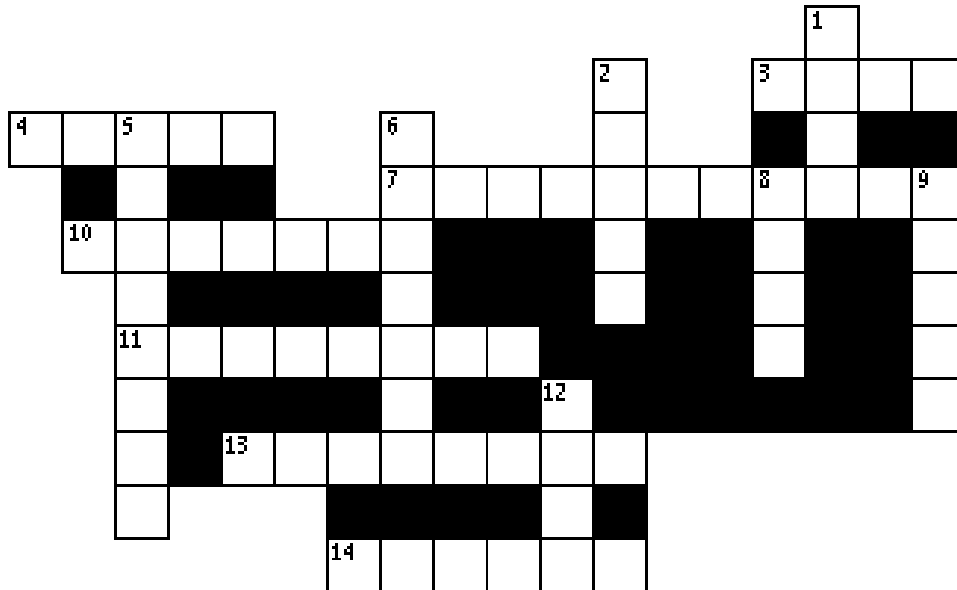


# 224. THE GREAT COMMANDMENT

- 10 ACROSS "There is no other commandment \_\_\_\_\_ than these." **MARK 12:31**
- 9 DOWN "So the scribe said to Him, 'Well said, Teacher. You have spoken the \_\_\_\_\_,..." **MARK 12:32**
- 3 ACROSS "...And to love one's neighbor as oneself, is \_\_\_\_\_ than all the whole burnt offerings and sacrifices." **MARK 12:33**
- 14 ACROSS "So when Jesus saw that he answered \_\_\_\_\_, He said to him, 'You are not far from the kingdom of God.'" **MARK 12:34**
